## JUNIOR/SENIOR LEAGUE BY-LAWS CODE OF CONDUCT 2007

This Code of Conduct is intended to supplement the Junior/Senior League Regulations and Official Baseball Rules and shall in no way be in conflict with said rules. If a conflict exists, it will be resolved in favor of the Junior/Senior League Regulations and Official Baseball Rules, in that order.

This Code of Conduct becomes effective upon a simple majority vote of the unit League Representatives at any pre-season meeting. The Code of Conduct Rules shall be reaffirmed in each subsequent season.

### A. CODE OF CONDUCT:

1. No Manager, Coach, or Player shall: At any time lay a hand upon, shove, strike or threaten an official, or be guilty of physical attack as an aggressor upon any Manager, Coach, Player and Official or Spectator.

\*\*\* Officials are required to immediately suspend such person from further play and report such person (s) to the Duty Officer. Should the incident occur either before the game begins or after the game is complete or from within the spectator area such incidents will still be reported to the Duty Officer. Duty Officer to submit incident report to President of team/Player, Manager etc. involved. The President will contact either Assistant District Administrators to schedule an Inter League meeting. Such person (s) will remain suspended until their case has been reviewed by the Inter League Board and Assistant District Administrators and a final report filed in writing to the District Administrator within 48 hours. Field Host (s) to supply Duty Officer to each Junior/Senior. game.

2. No Manager, Coach, or Player shall: Refuse to abide by the Officials decisions.

\*\*\* Officials are required to immediately suspend such person (s).

3. No player shall: Be guilty of using unnecessary rough tactics in the play of the game against the body or person of an opposing player.

\*\*\* Umpire is required to immediately suspend such player (s).

4. No Manager, Coach or Player shall: Appear upon the field of play at anytime in an intoxicated condition or under the influence of drugs.

\*\*\* Officials are required to immediately suspend such person (s).

5. No Manager, Coach or Player shall: Use tobacco in any form on the field of play or in the dugout.
6. No spectator shall: Appear on the field of play (EXCEPTIONS: When a critical injury occurs, time is called and it is deemed advisable to call for the assistance of a spectator).
7. No alcoholic beverage shall be consumed at a Little League game. It is against the law for anyone to consume an alcoholic beverage on school grounds or park grounds. It shall be each league's responsibility to see that this rule is adhered to. It shall be the responsibility of the Host League to provide a Duty Officer at each game. If Duty Officer sees anyone consuming any alcoholic beverage within the playing field boundaries, the Duty Officer shall contact the police dept. to have the individual (s) removed from the premises. A full written report (Incident Report) shall be provided to the Assistant District Administrators.
8. No Manager, Coach or Player shall use profanity, racial language or sexually derogatory statements. It is the Manager's responsibility to see that he and his coaches and players refrain from using filthy or obscene language.

\*\*\* Any player found to be using any form of gang related hand or verbal signs of language shall be removed from the game and the umpire is required to give the Assistant District Administrators a written report within 24 hours. A second offense will result in review of the full Inter League Board.

\*\*\* No Player shall at any time write on or have writing placed upon their hats except that which has been approved by the Board of Directors.

9. Umpires are to report all suspensions or ejections to their association advisor.
10. All suspensions & ejections are brought before Kimberly & Randy the Assistant District Administrators call us for documentation, ie pitch count offences.

\*\*\* Such person (s) will remain suspended until their case has been reviewed by the Assistant District Administrators and a final report filed in writing .

**THERE SHALL BE NO ALTERATIONS TO THE CODE OF CONDUCT WITHOUT WRITTEN PERMISSION FROM ASSISTANT DISTRICT ADMINISTRATORS. NO ALTERATIONS TO GAME SCHEDULES SHALL BE MADE WITHOUT PRIOR NOTICE OF ASSISTANT DISTRICT ADMINISTRATORS.**

11. Minimum play: Receiving a copy of the "Code of Conduct" constitutes written warning of minimum play requirement.
  - A. First violation: Manager/Coach is suspended from their next physically played game.
  - B. Second violation: Manager/Coach is suspended for their next 2 physically played games.
  - C. Third violation: Suspended for remainder of season.

\*\*\* Field Host (s) will supply a Duty Officer Information packet to include Scorebook Rosters (uniform #, name, league age). Along with Official Scorebook. Guidelines for official scorekeeper: First, official scorekeeper is an individual from the Home team preferably. Second, visitors' team, Third, Duty Officer, Fourth, Coach from either team. If the Coach is to be the official scorekeeper he is to sit in stands. His role as coach will be suspended until the end of the game.

\*\*\* Scorebooks must list absent players, players' number of defensive outs and completed plate appearances for each substitute and removed starter.

\*\*\* The official scorekeeper shall record any minimum play violations in the scorebook and notify the umpire, who will notify the offending manager, RULE 4.19 (d). League Division VP shall be notified within 24 hours by duty officer (Field Host) who will notify Kimberly (ADA) or Randy (ADA). The offending Manager shall meet with the Inter League Board and Assistant District Administrators within 72 hours

\*\*\* Dress Code: Shirts tucked in, not baggy, must look like a ball player. **NO GANG INSIGNIA OF ANY KIND WILL BE ALLOWED ON UNIFORM.**

## 2007 JR/SR INTER LEAGUE RULES

1. The HOME TEAM will provide THREE NEW BALLS for each game, and the visiting team will provide TWO GOOD BALLS. Because the baseballs are generally not retrieved or returned, it is suggested that BOTH TEAMS have extra baseballs.
2. Pitching Affidavits (including pitch count) **MUST** follow the team to every game and given to official scorekeeper before the start of each game that they may determine eligibility of pitchers. They must be filled out correctly and signed by the official scorekeeper (HOME TEAM) of each game. These must be filled out in INK not pencil. A game is not official if the affidavit is missing. If affidavit and pitch count record are not provided Manager/Coach will be suspended from next physically played game.
3. No new inning to begin after 2 ½ hours. If the inning begins before this time, then the inning will be played out (tied game WILL continue to a maximum of 3 hours).
4. Both teams are responsible for the preparation of the playing field prior to each game. Both teams are also responsible for placing field equipment away and for cleaning the dugouts and bleacher areas after each game.
5. If a game goes over the time limit the next scheduled game (same field) will begin ½ hour after the completion of the prior game.
6. If a Manager/Coach/Player is ejected from a game they are to leave the field immediately. He/She may sit in their car in the parking lot until the game is over (Player is to be supervised by a team parent).
7. Manager/Coach/Player **MUST NOT** attend suspended game. Player Agent is to inform opposing leagues division representative with player (s) name and date (s) suspended for. A suspension will be noted in the official scorebook in **ink**.
8. In all cases of a player/Coach/Manager ejection Kimberly or Randy from District **MUST** be contacted.
9. There will be a 10 run Mercy Rule after 4 ½ innings if Home team is ahead for Juniors and Seniors.
10. If a team is unable to field 9 players, that team Manager or League Representative must notify the opposing team Manager and the Umpire Service immediately, if at all possible within 24-hours prior to the scheduled game time. If the Umpire Services is not given 24-hour notice and you are the visiting team, who is unable to field the team, your League will be billed for umpires. If the home team is unable to field a complete team, the home team is billed for the umpires.
11. If a team is unable to field 9 players during the course of a game, the game will only be made up at the end of the season, if it affects the standings.
12. Base coaches shall be eligible players in uniform of their team or 2 adult managers or coaches of their team.

Rule 1.11 will be strictly enforced.

REPORT OF UNUSUAL OCCURRENCE/INCIDENT REPORT

Please be specific as possible and avoid personal judgments or conclusions. This report must be forwarded within 24 hours to the Inter League Committee.
